Section 98c - State School Aid Act for 2022-23

Section 98c are federal funds to address learning loss as part of the Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund and part of the federal Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) II Fund.



98c Grant Timeline

- **October 30th: Board presentation**
 - **November 30th: Application due**
 - **December-January: MDE informs districts of actual grant amount**
 - **June 30th: Funds spent**
 - **July 14th: Districts report to MDE**
 - **August 15th: MDE reports to legislature**
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How much will Grant Public Schools Receive?

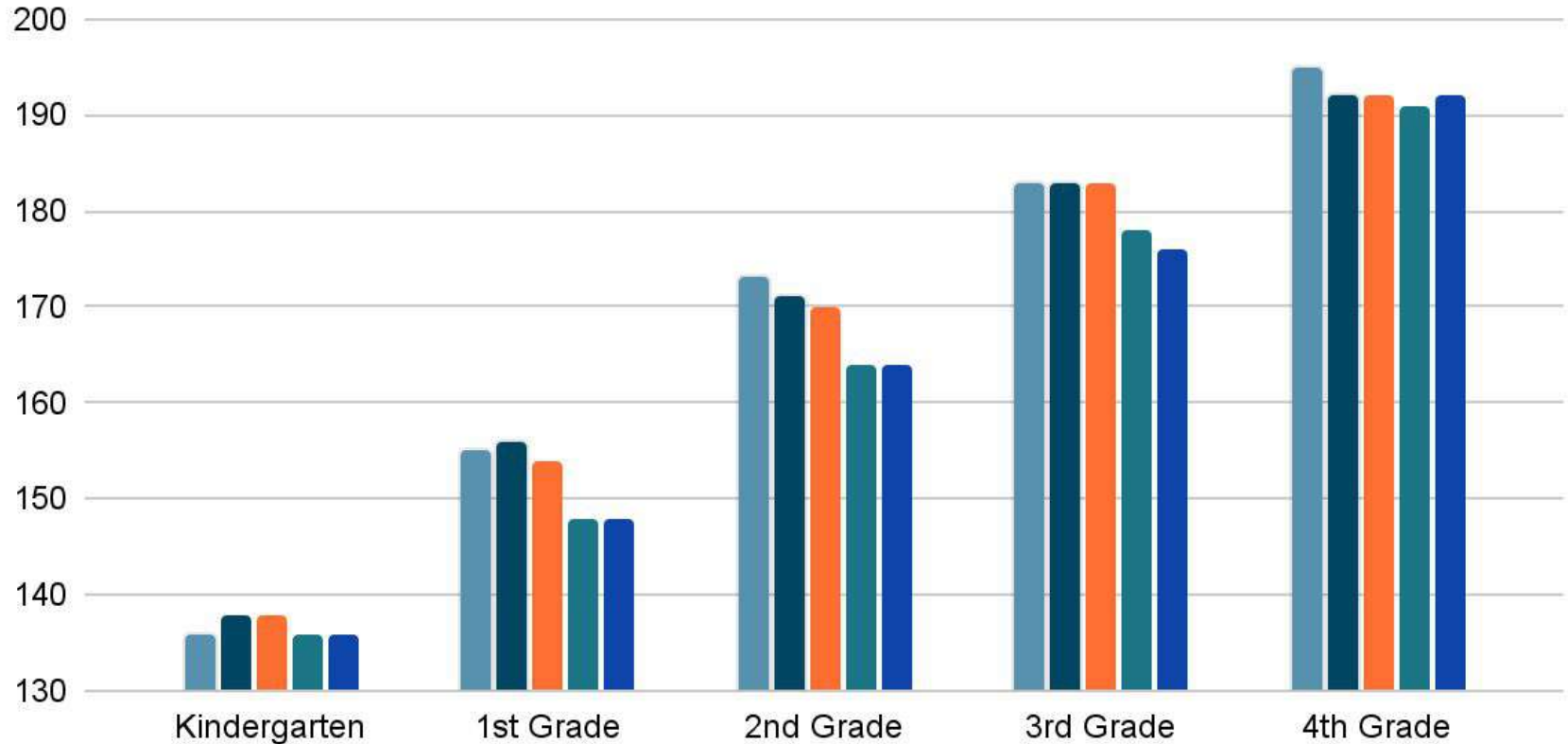
- Funding will be distributed equally to each district applying based on per pupil membership.
 - MDE calculates the amount and is anticipating district will receive funds early winter.
 - \$52,056,000 in federal funds are part of section 98c. Based on how many districts apply before the application window is closed will determine local district funding allocations.

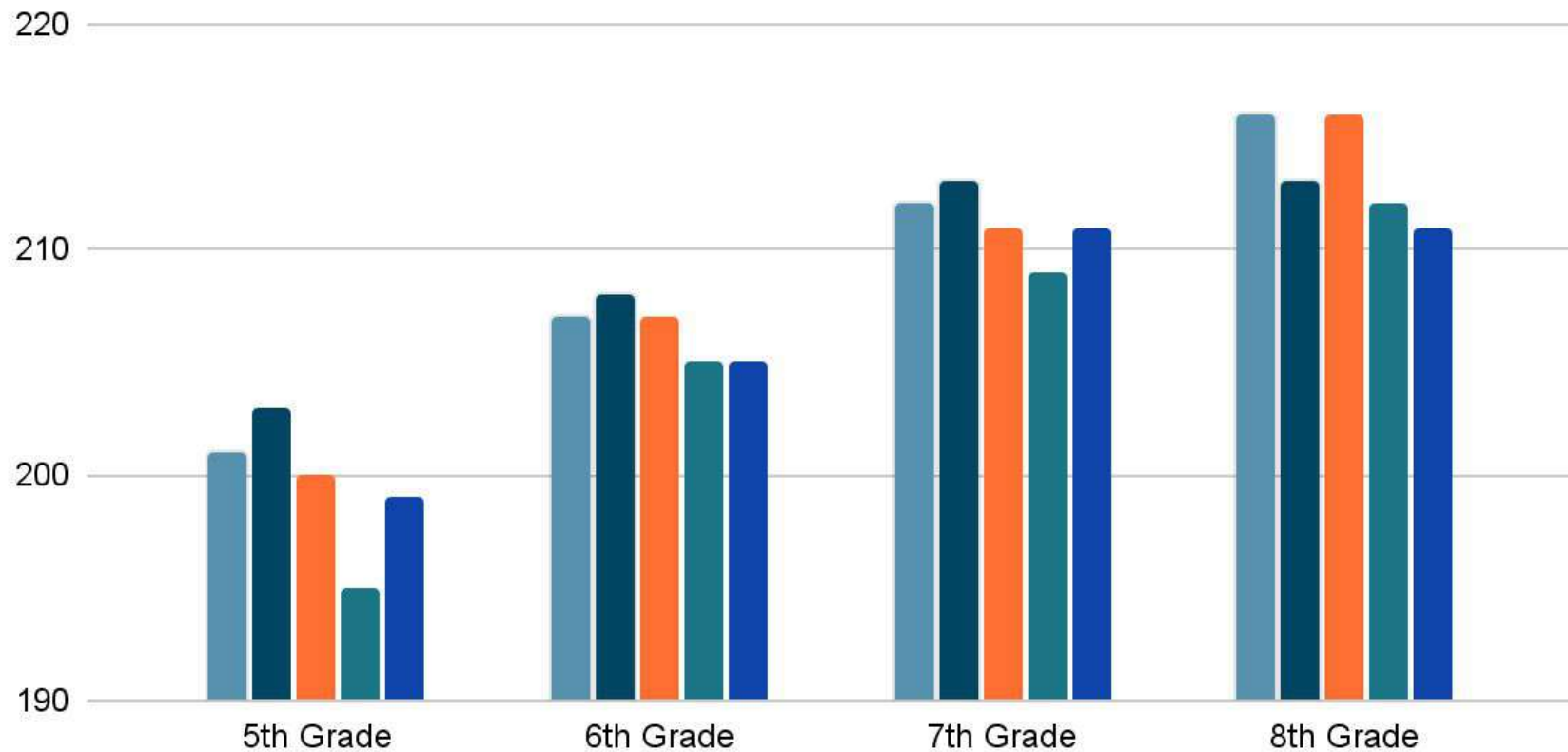
Fall MAP Average RIT - Reading

2018 2019 2020 2021 2022



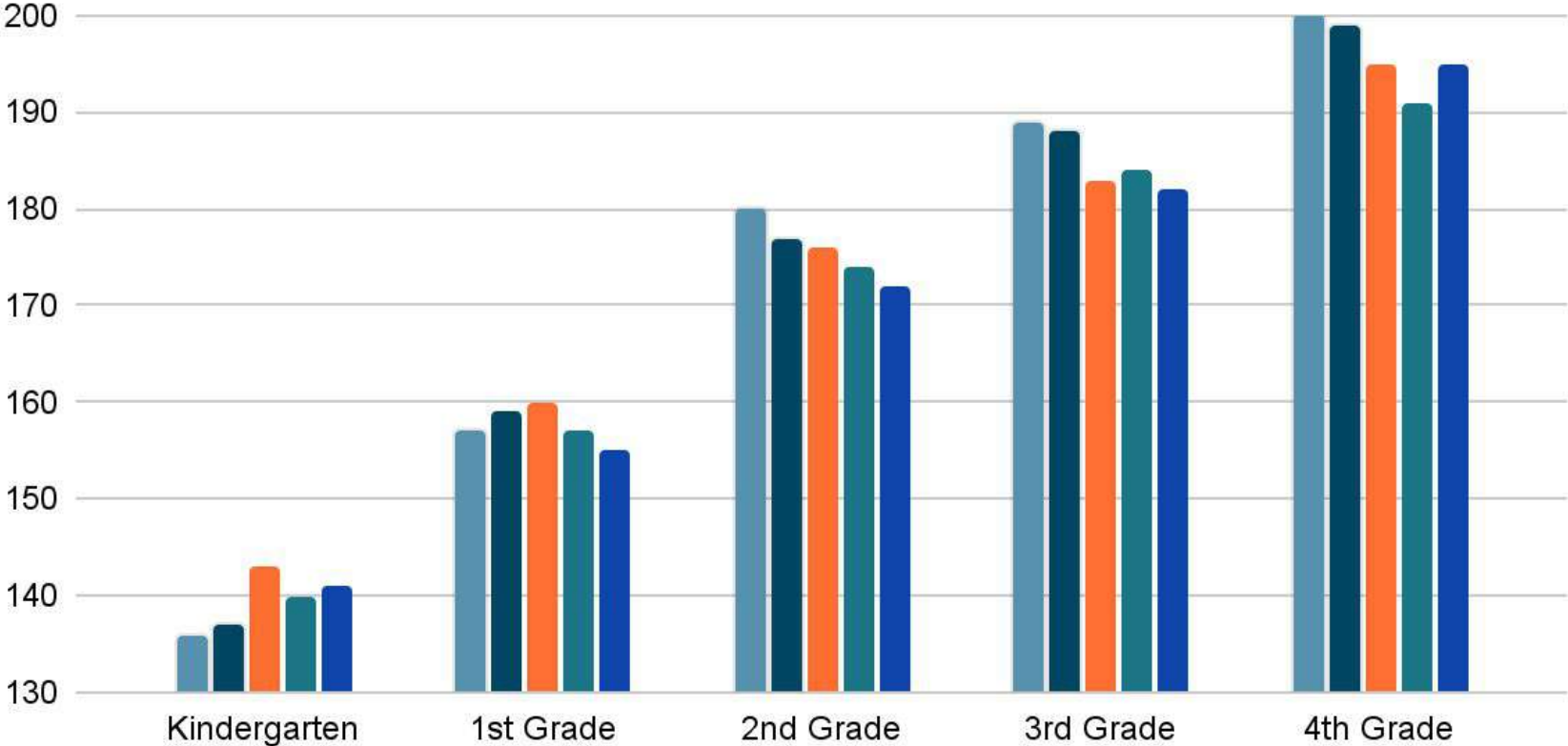
Fall MAP Average RIT - Reading

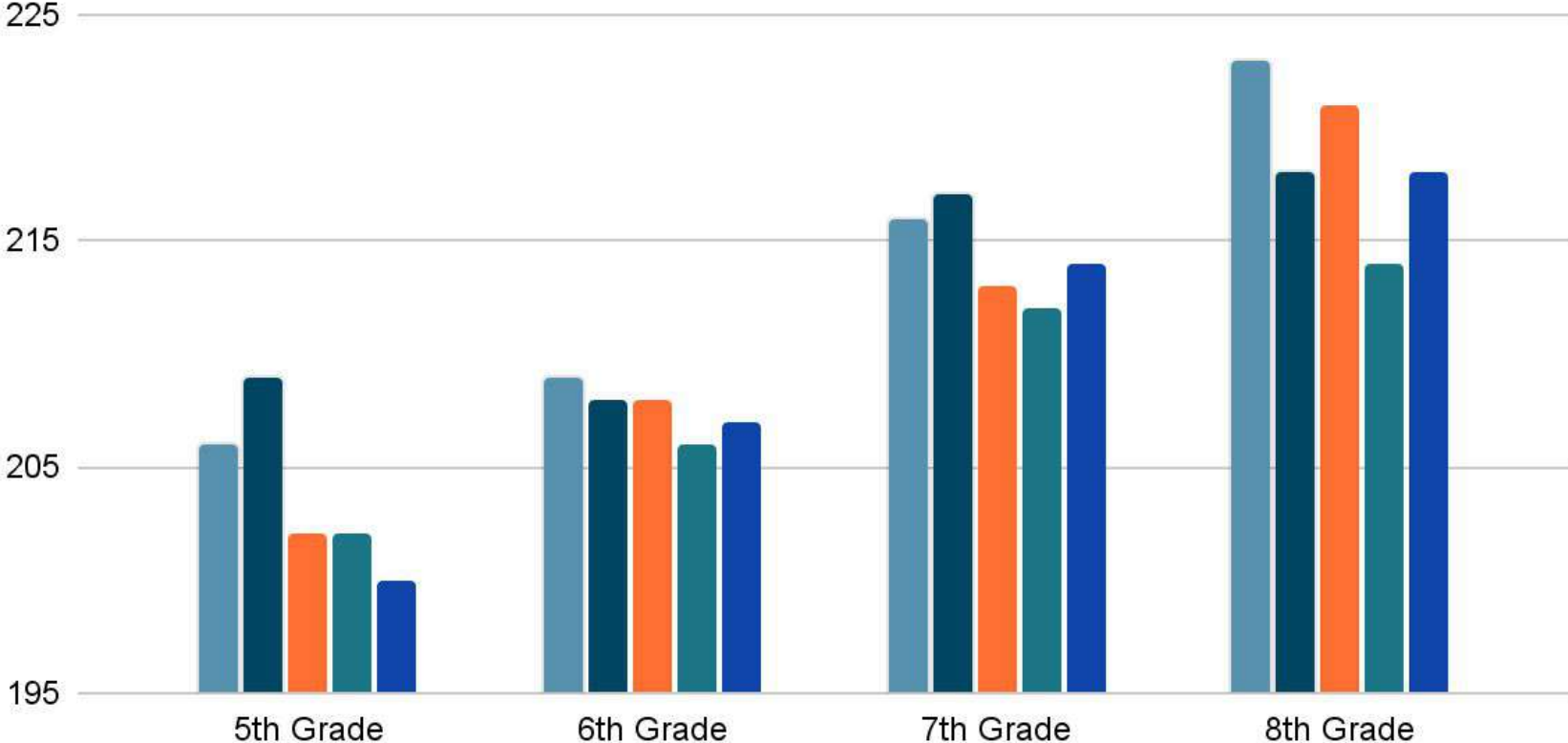
Fall MAP Average RIT - Math

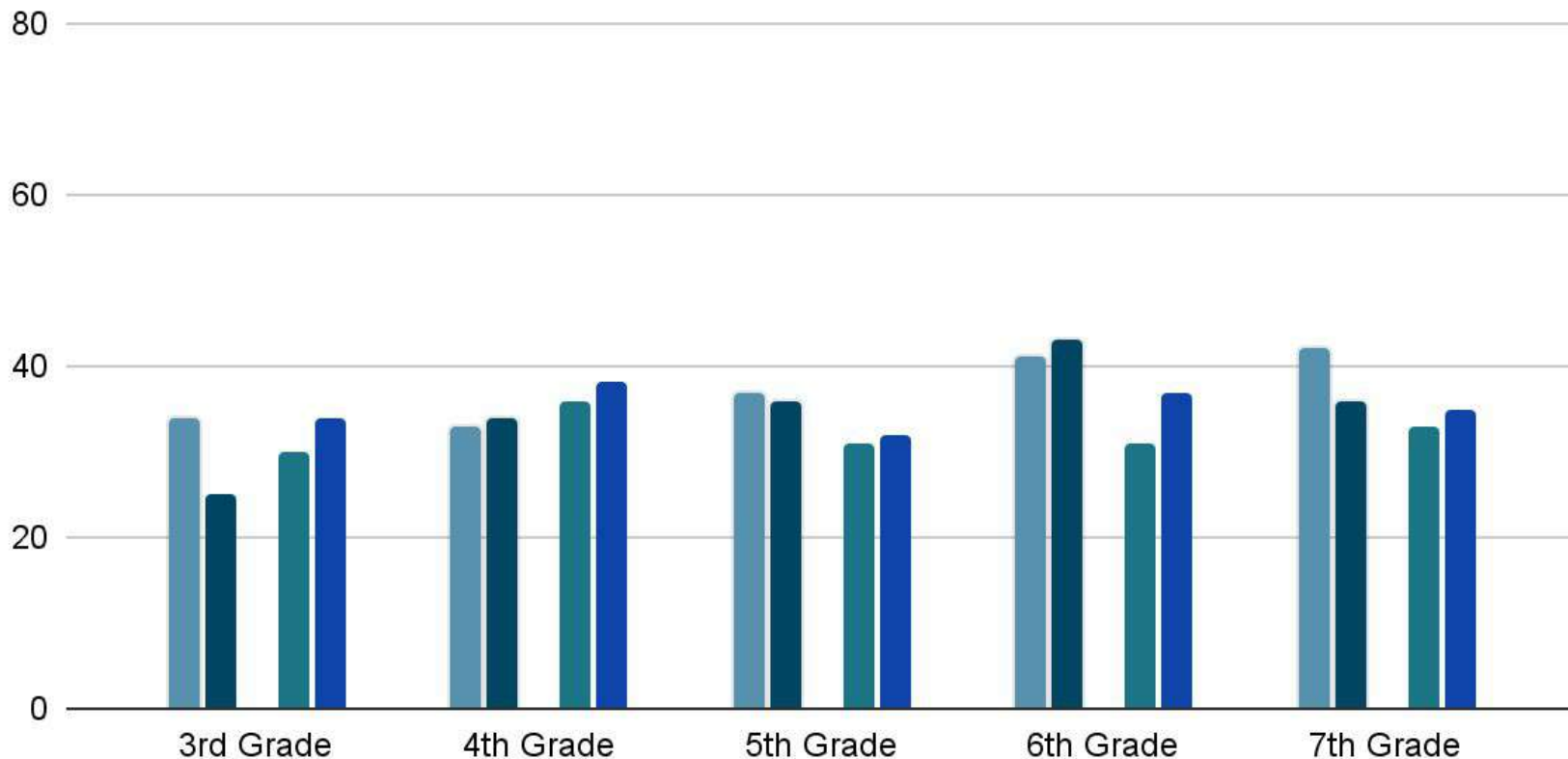
